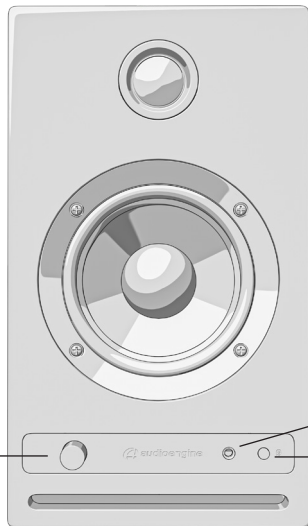

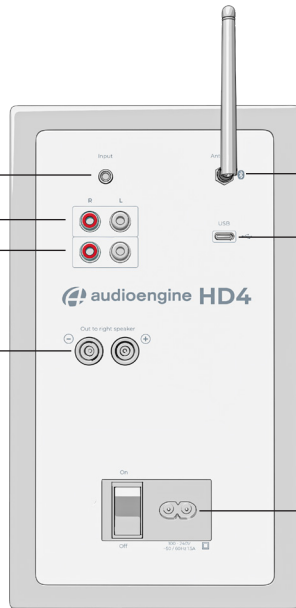

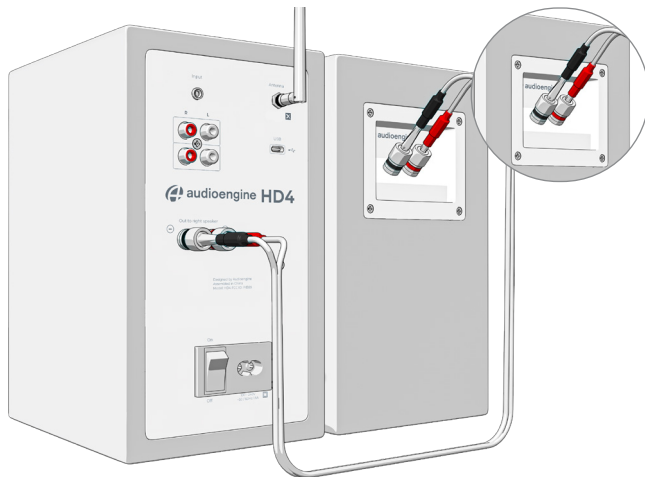

QUICK SETUP- CONNECT



STEP 1

Connect the included speaker wire to the HD4 left (powered) speaker connection and into the color matching posts on the right (passive) speaker connection.

Verify that the matching speaker wires are going to the same terminals on both speakers.

POWER

STEP 2

Connect the power cable to the power connection on the HD4 powered speaker rear panel.

Plug the power cable into a functioning power outlet.

Flip the power switch to the on position. The pair light on the front of the HD4 powered speaker will begin to blink.



WIRELESS CONNECTION

STEP 3

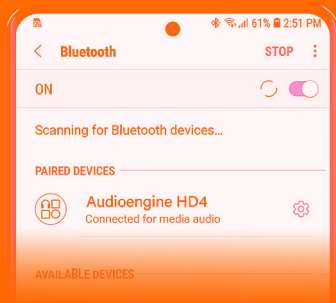
If this is your first time setting up Bluetooth, the HD4 will automatically go into Bluetooth “pair mode” and the pair button on the front panel will start flashing.

On your Bluetooth enabled device, such as a smart phone, turn on Bluetooth and go to Bluetooth preferences.

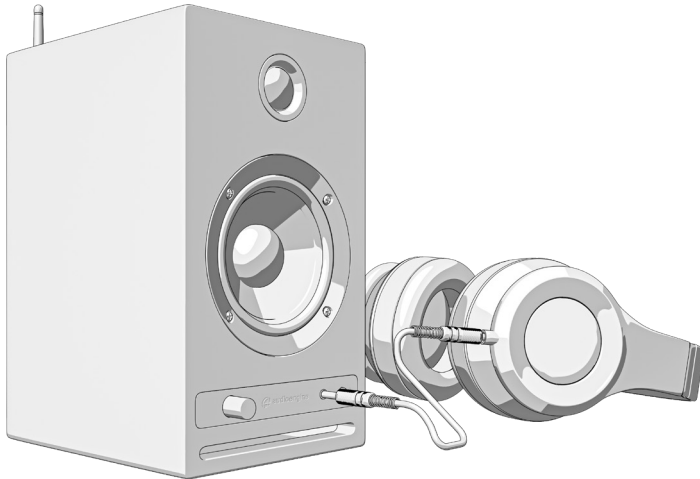
Select “Audioengine HD4” to pair and connect.

The Pair indicator light on the HD4 powered front panel should now be solid.

Play your music and adjust the volume on both your speakers and your device to your desired listening levels.

The HD4 will automatically switch the output from the speakers to any headphones plugged into the front headphone output port. The HD4 volume knob can be used to adjust the level of amplification.

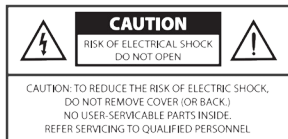
